

Top 10 Things to Remember for Residents and Renters in Cisco

- 1.) **Keep speed at or below 15 MPH. “If you’re raising dust you MUST slow down!”**
- 2.) **Watch for pedestrians and cyclists. They are everywhere. Be especially careful when crossing the bike path.**
- 3.) **Don’t drive or park on the moors. They are fragile and help prevent erosion. There is limited parking available near the beach access points. Use wagons or carts to transport your beach gear and leave the car at home.**
- 4.) **Nantucket is a dog friendly place, but there are rules. Please pick up after your dogs, and don’t leave them outside unattended to bark at passing cars, deer, etc.**
- 5.) **Don’t litter. If you see someone else’s litter, pick it up.**
- 6.) **Remove invasive plants and dead trees from your property.**
- 7.) **Respect your neighbors – no noise between 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM. (Remember, sound carries a long distance in our neighborhood.)**
- 8.) **Fireworks of any sort are illegal in Massachusetts, and present a significant fire hazard.**
- 9.) **Please preserve our night sky and turn off outdoor lights once you have returned home for the evening.**
